"COUNSELOR'S MAIL BAG"

Foreclosure! Foreclosure! Foreclosure!

Greetings and Happy New Year!

Aside from our homeownership readiness workshops and credit and budget counseling, we provide foreclosure mitigation services to homeowners who have experienced hardships that have led to them not being able to maintain their mortgages.

Foreclosure sometimes is inevitable and a very hard topic to discuss. While you may not want to address this head on, it is important to seek help as soon as possible to avoid losing your home. There are many hardships that can be faced in the months following holidays that include employment changes, increased expenses and emergency repairs for home maintenance issues.

Here is a list of things that you can do to be proactive if you face any of the above or similar:

- Contact a HUD-approved housing agency **IMMEDIATELY!! DO NOT WAIT!!** (Salisbury NHS)
- Contact your mortgage servicer to explore your options and explain your situation
- **BEWARE OF SCAMS** and anyone asking for money up-front to save your home. Do not send any money to anyone other than your mortgage servicer!!!
- Continue making payments if the mortgage servicer will accept them. *Article continued on pg. 3.

"COUNSELOR'S MAIL BAG" CONT'

- If payments are no longer being accepted, save as much as you can and adjust your budget accordingly.
- Collect all proof of income, bank statements, budgets and all other documentation being requested by your housing counselor and the mortgage servicer.
- If you receive notice of a sale date, contact your local legal aid service IMMEDIATELY!!
- Be sure to keep in touch with both the mortgage servicer and your housing counselor as you are being assisted through the application process to be aware of your timeline.
- Explore back-up plans in case you have to relocate.

While your housing counselor will work to achieve the best possible outcome for your situation, always keep in mind that nothing is guaranteed. Having an optimistic mind as well as knowing that you may need to have a back-up plan will be beneficial throughout this process. Only send money to your mortgage servicer. If they are not your servicer, say no and walk away!
