Q3 Newsletter—July 2019

For those of you who are looking for a little light summer reading, a recent study was conducted by local leaders on the Lower Shore that aimed to help the community understand the impact the

non-profit sector has on Wicomico, Worcester, Somerset and Dorchester Counties. While it does not detail what specific impact SNHS has, I encourage you to read this informative report. Key findings include:

- Nonprofits on the Lower Eastern Shore have a total economic impact of over \$695 million annually.
- The nonprofit sector supports over 9,200 jobs on the Lower Eastern Shore, contributing over \$379 million in 2017 to the region's economy through wages paid (14% of the region's total wages).
- Approximately 1 in 3 Lower Shore neighbors are served directly and indirectly by local nonprofits.
- Despite the large impact of the nonprofit sector, organizations still face many obstacles including struggles to raise funds that cover full costs, insufficient staff or volunteers for workloads, and challenges to offer competitive pay.

Fishing vs. Phishing - Are you Getting Caught?

Don't get caught this summer with finding yourself in a situation of internet money fraud. Instead, spend the months outside enjoying the weather and doing a little fishing with a rod and reel. In the event you do suspect internet fraud, here are signs to consider:

- Are you receiving e-mails from a legitimate e-mail address? Check the address to see if it looks suspicious.
 - Do not provide your personal information to anyone whom you were not expecting contact from. (i.e. social security numbers or credit card information)
 - Do not leave your computer running or unlocked all the time. This could make it more prone to hackers and spyware.
- Change your password information frequently and do not have the same log-in and username for all of your online accounts.
 - Do not send money to anyone you do not recognize.
 - Call the company who is requesting the information before clicking on any links in an e-mail. You should always be familiar with whom you are doing business with.
 - Scams can come in multiple forms. Popular ways are through e-mail, phone calls and text messages.
