Preparing for Fall and the Upcoming Holidays

- · Max. loan amount, \$15,000 and min. loan amount, \$1,000

- Interest rate will conform to the 1st mortgage interest rate
- Property must be owner occupied
- Additional rules and restrictions apply

DOWNPAYMENT AND CLOSING COST ASSISTANCE GRANTS STILL AVAILABLE

Downpayment/Closing cost assistance grants for eligible homeowners purchasing in the City limits of Salisbury are still available. An applicant's total household income must be less than 80% of the area median income based on household size. Eligible applicants may receive up to \$5,000 in homebuyer assistance.

1 person \$38,300 **2 person** \$43,800 **3 person** \$49,250

4 person \$54,700 **5 person** \$59,100 **6 person** \$63,500

7 person \$67,850 **8 person** \$72,250

These figures represent 80% of Area Median Income for Salisbury. They are to be used as an index for determining income eligibility for programs where household income is limited to "at or below 80% of Area Median Income."
