When facing eviction, or when homeless, Wicomico County residents can get everything from rent assistance to shelter and more. Low income families or individuals in need may also receive grants for paying rent, legal aid, as well as take advantage of homeless prevention and rapid rehousing programs.

Housing and rental assistance can be provided from many different agencies in Wicomico County. Whether it is a grant or loan to help pay delinquent rent, emergency shelter, transitional housing or more, support is offered. Please know that funding for these programs may be based on availability and method of contact or hours of operation may change due to the pandemic.
